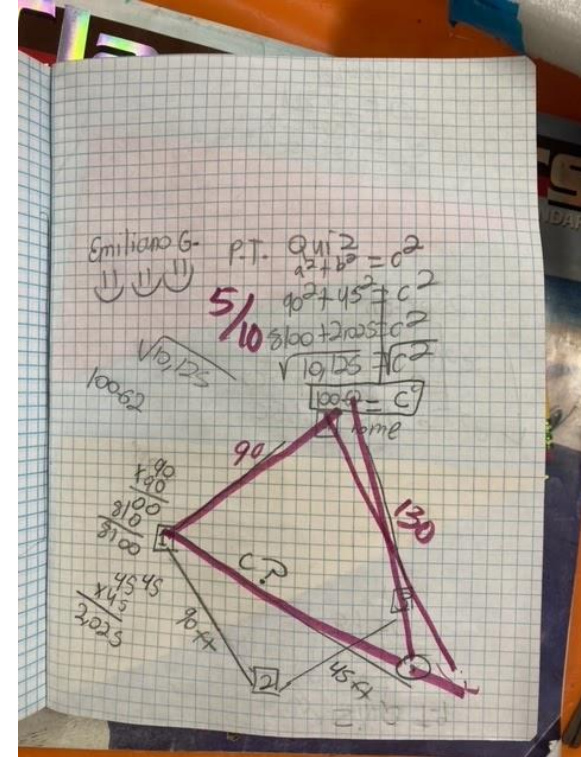


# Reflection on My PT quiz

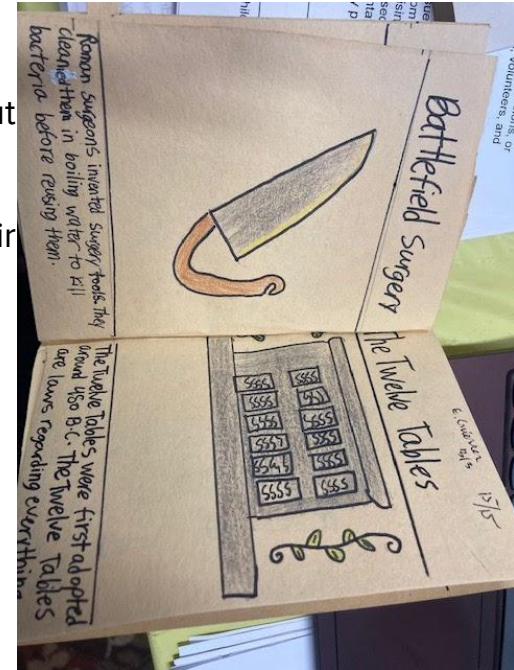


# Reflection on Rome Test Part 3

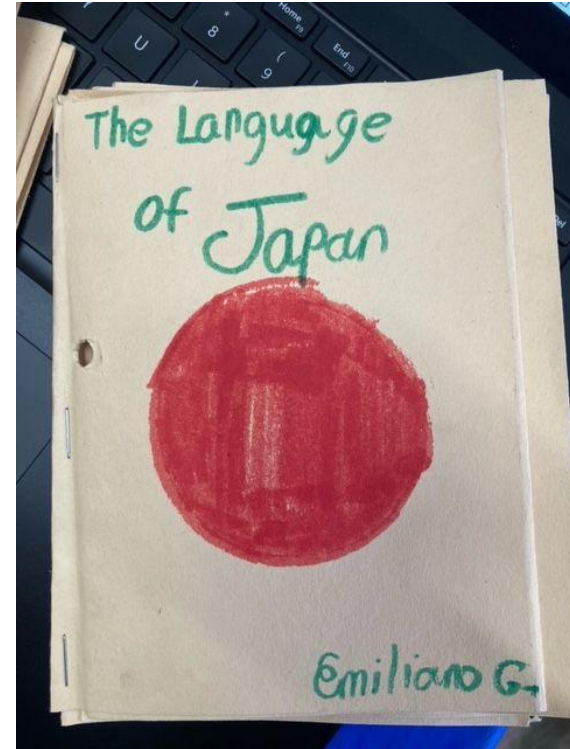


# Reflection on The Language of Japan

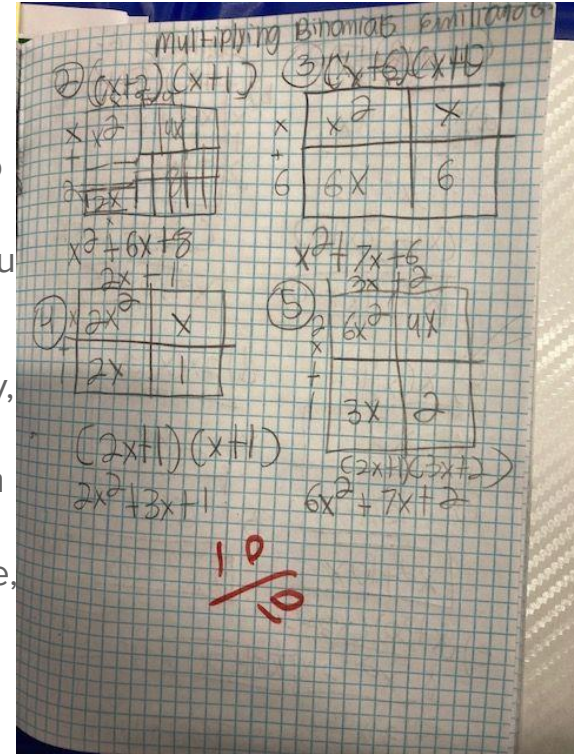


# Reflection on the Generic Rectangle

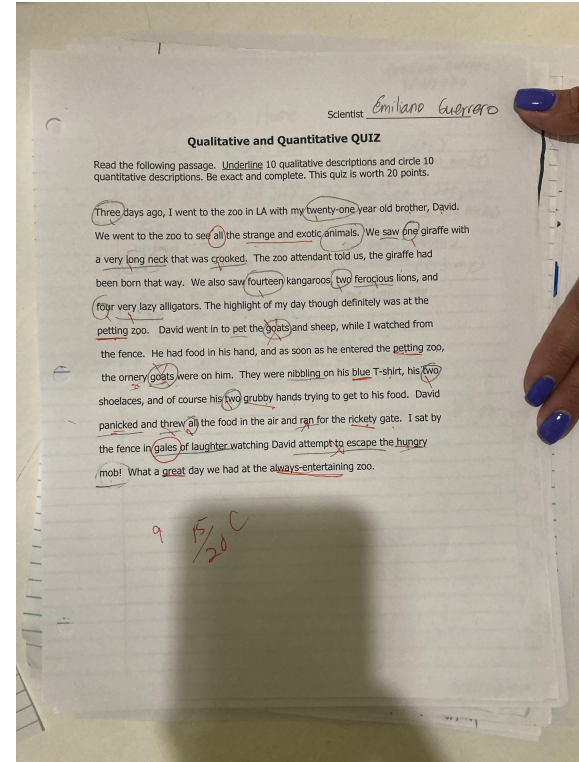


# Reflection on Q & Q Quiz

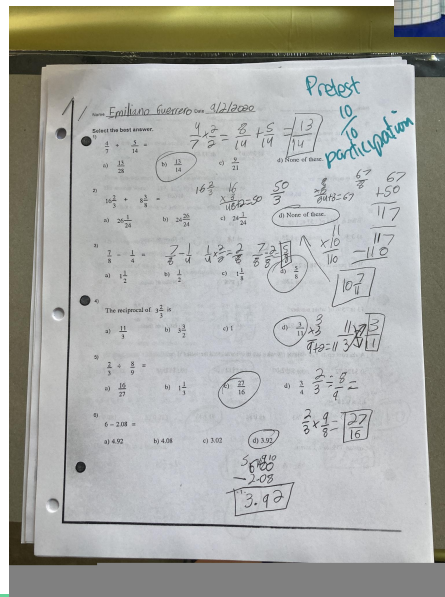
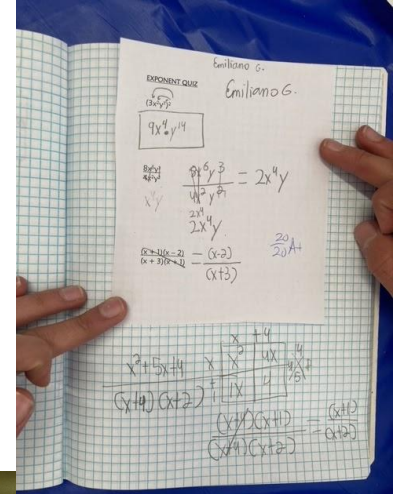
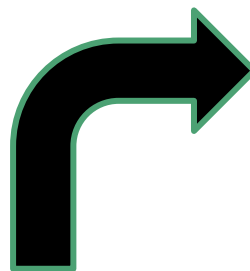
# Reflection on Gs-3 and YS-20-23

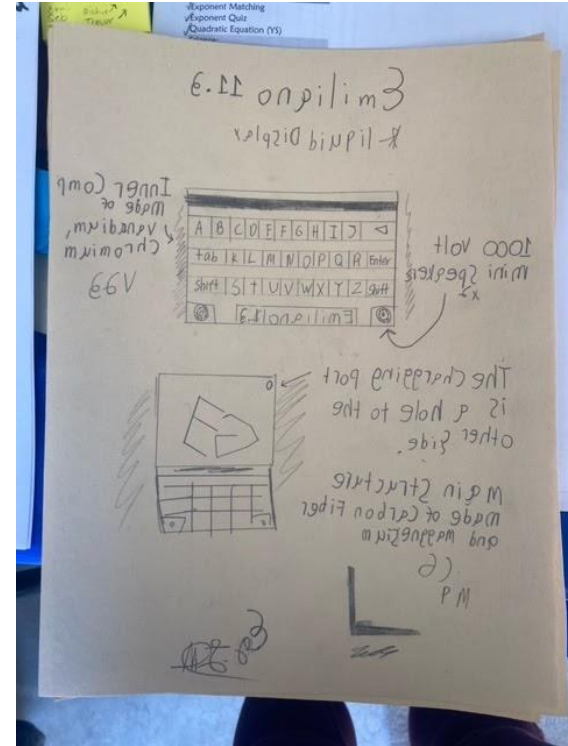


# Reflection on the Renaissance

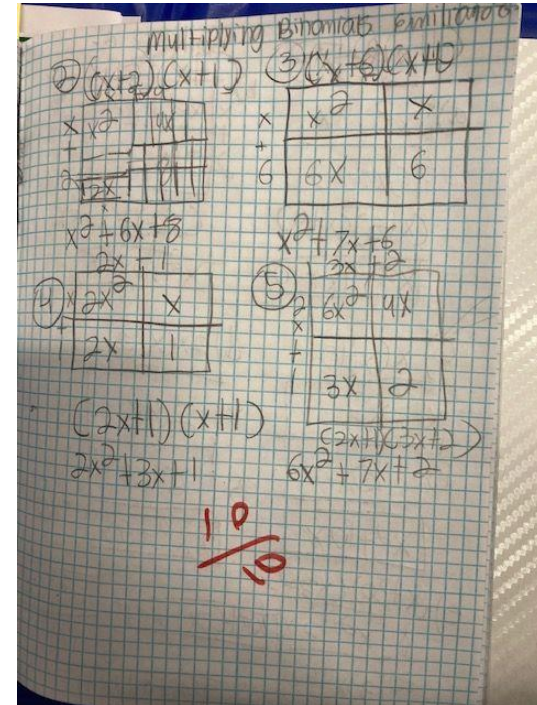


# Reflection on Solving Quadratics
