Think Fast! Name Jonathan

The time it takes for your ears to send a message to your brain, and your body to respond is called **reaction time**.

Let's try an experiment to test your reaction time.

Materials: 30 cm metric ruler.
Procedure:

1. Place your left arm on a table with your hand over the edge.
2. Space your thumb and index fingers about 4 cm apart.
3. Have a partner hold the "30 cm end" of the ruler, with the other end just above your open thumb and index finger.
4. Your partner will say "set," and drop the ruler.
5. Catch the ruler with your thumb and index finger as quickly as possible.
6. Check the distance fallen by taking a reading at the bottom of the index finger.
7. Record your results.
8. Repeat the procedure 10 times with each hand.
